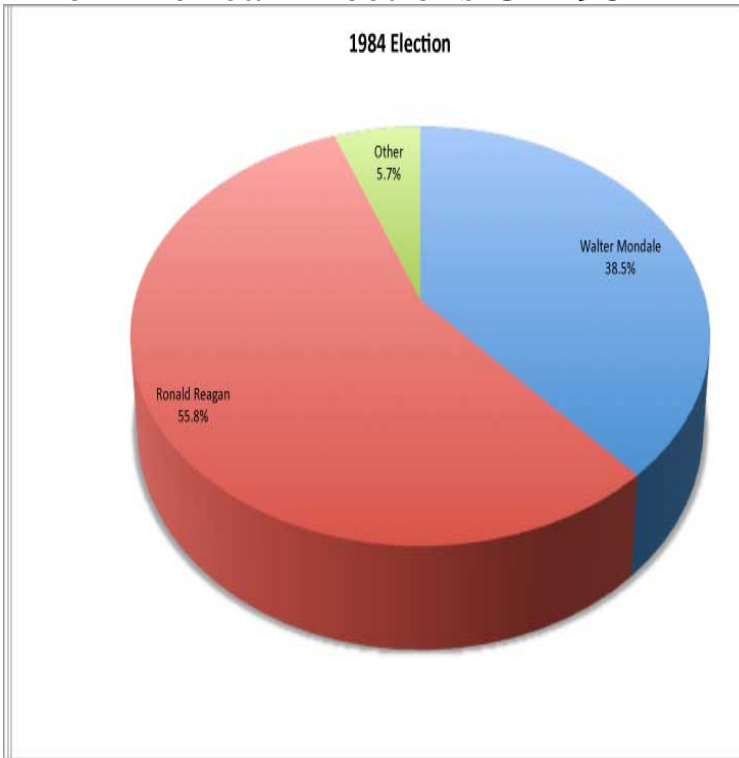


The American Elections Of 1984
